## Wreath Donation Guidelines

You are invited to participate in our Aberdeen Festival of Trees by decorating and donating a Christmas wreath or wall hanging to be placed in competition and be auctioned through "silent auction" at this event. All decorated wreaths and wall hangings become the property of the Aberdeen Chamber of Commerce and the proceeds from the auction of these wreaths and wall hangings will be donated to the University of Maryland Upper Chesapeake Health Foundation. Decorated wreaths and wall hangings will be on display to the public on Friday evening,



December 6<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup> at TB3 Event Center, 203 W. Bel Air Ave., Aberdeen.

## The following deadlines and regulations apply to donors and decorators of wreaths and wall hangings. Please read carefully.

If you have further questions or need clarification, please contact Vickie Horne at 410-272-1600 x213. Things to remember when decorating your wreath:

- A wreath hanger must be used. However, plastic hangers are not permitted.
- Nails and screws are not allowed. Only removable adhesive hooks are permitted to attach anything to the doors, walls or windows or hide electrical cords.
- Must be artificial.
- All decorations must be nonflammable or fireproof.
- The minimum wreaths size is 16 inches in diameter.
- A Christmas, winter theme, and lighted wreaths sell the best.
- Make sure the construction is sturdy and durable and that quality materials are used.
- Grapevine, straw, hay, etc. are not permitted.
- All wreaths become the property of the Aberdeen Chamber of Commerce.
- Displays cannot extend further than the width of a door.

The following items are **PROHIBITED** – unwrapped edible items, spray adhesives, glitter, confetti, artificial snow. Glitter covered ornaments are permissible, but all preparations must be done prior to arrival at the venue. No spraying after arrival will be permitted.

Decorations **MUST BE WIRED TO THE WERATH SECURELY.** Please make sure your wreath is stable and secure. No active (flashing, blinking, and twinkling) lighting is permitted.

SET-UP – Stars Friday, December 6 at 9:00am and ends at 12:00pm.

Please arrive early. We recommend your wreath be completely decorated and ready for hanging upon arrival. The design team will arrange wreaths for the best viewing by the public. When you arrive, you will be directed to where to place your wreath. Aberdeen Main Street will provide extension cords for all wreaths needing electricity. Take all the boxes, storage, and containers home with you. We ask that you not have children under the age of 10 with you during setup.

PUBLIC VIEWING - The Aberdeen Festival of Trees will be open to the public on Friday, December 6, from 6:00-8:00PM and Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, from 9:00AM-3:00PM.

We ask you to help by creating and donating a decorated wreath for this event. Wreaths will be placed in two categories, "Best in Show" and "Most Creative." Friday night patrons will be asked to vote. Winning wreaths will be on display Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup>.
